

The 11th One coin time challenge

- Reception between 8:55 and 11:30 at the middle of Bouyou course.
(use king holiday lift)
- Competition between 9:00 and 12:00
- Awards ceremony 14:00 outdoors on the mountain side of the Mountain Center. (Absence will result in forfeiture of the awards ceremony, but substitutes are accepted)
- Participation fee 500 yen per person (exact change please)
- No prior registration is required. On the day of the event, participants pay the participation fee at the starting point, receive a number tag, and wear it to start skiing.
- Skiing, snowboarding, and telemark skiing: Anyone of any age or gender who can safely ski down the course is welcome.
- After each person's first run, they will use that time as a reference and write their subsequent run times on a time declaration form near the goal, then post it.
- After that, they will be ranked higher in the order of their declared time for up to three runs.
- The time will be displayed on the time display at near the goal.
- The display is up to 1/100 of a second, but since it is measured to 1/1000 of a second, you can declare it to 1/1000 of a second.
- Awards All ski equipment, ages, and genders are mixed
 - 1st to 6th place
 - Junping awards for every 10th place
 - Special award

Other (Participants agree to the following items)

- Please start each time you arrive at the starting point.
- You cannot change the time you declared.
- The race may be cancelled due to bad weather, etc, and if the race is stopped midway due to unavoidable circumstances, the time up to that point will be used to calculate the race results.
- Please refrain from timing yourself with a clock or other device while skiing.
- If any damage or harm occurs during the event, I will deal with it at my own risk and will not hold the organizers responsible.
- Photos and videos taken during the event may be used by the organizers.
- IF a racer does not pass a gate unless it is intentional, they will not be disqualified.
- **We ask that all players help with the cleanup as much as possible.**
